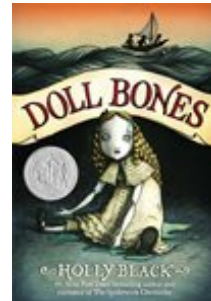
Uncle Sam Wants You! (November 11 at 2:00pm)
