

# Hot Mess Flower Canvas

## Supplies included:

8x8 inch canvas  
Paint palette—*pink, orange, yellow, purple, blue & green*  
Paint brush  
Adhesive vinyl flower stencil with clear contact paper for placing on canvas  
Bottle of white paint  
Toothpick

## Additional supplies needed:

Cup with water for cleaning paint brush  
Plate for white paint  
Paper towels  
Something to protect work surface



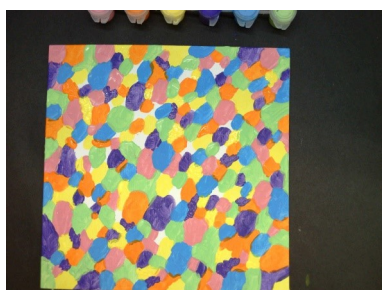
## Step 1

Working through paint palette, randomly paint shapes on canvas. Paint dots, stripes, diamonds, or squares!



## Step 2

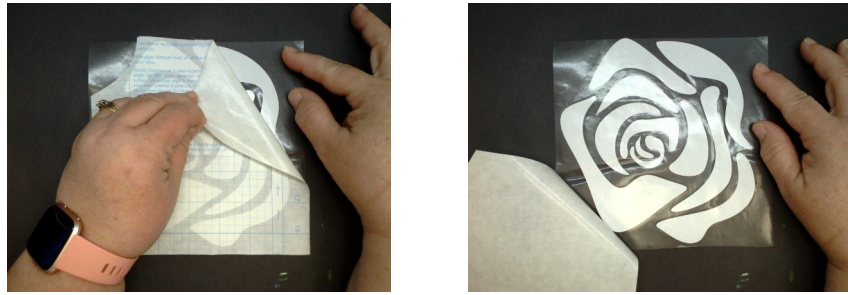
After working through paint palette, go through it again so that there is **no white** left on the canvas. Let the paint dry completely before going to the next step.





### Step 3

Remove paper backing of vinyl flower making sure that the adhesive vinyl flower is attached to the clear contact paper.



### Step 4

Attach adhesive vinyl flower to canvas, then remove clear contact paper. The flower may want to come back up with the contact paper but **slowly** roll contact paper away from canvas and rub flower pieces back down on canvas to make sure they're adhered to the canvas and prevent white paint bleeding into the flower.



### Step 5

Paint canvas completely white over vinyl flower. **Let paint dry completely**, then give canvas another coat of white paint.



### Step 6

Remove vinyl flower with toothpick.
