Coffee Creamer Snowman



Supplies needed:

Fleece fabric Pipe cleaner Pompoms Orange felt Buttons Plastic coffee creamer bottle (clear or white) Cotton balls (if using clear bottle) Black marker Scissors Hot glue gun and glue sticks OR craft glue

Step One: Prepare your snowman's body by removing the label. If using a clear container, fill the bottle with cotton balls. White paint could also be used to coat the inside of a clear container. Pour white paint into opening of bottle and tilt until all sides are coated. Add additional paint if need and let dry before putting lid back on bottle.





Step Two: Cut a strip of fabric approximately one inch wide for the scarf. Wrap the material around the "neck" to gauge length needed. Allow extra length for fringe or a knot, if desired. The scarf can either be tied on or glued. **Step Three:** Create a carrot nose by cutting a triangle out of orange felt or paper. Attach to the bottle with a small spot of glue. Using a black marker draw dots to create the snowman's eyes and mouth.





Step Four: Dress him up! Use buttons to decorate your snowman as you see fit. Pompoms and pipe cleaner can become earmuffs or create a hat with fabric and a pompom on top!
