Melted Crayon Necklace

Supplies Needed:

- Crayons
- Pendant with cabochons
- Necklace cord
- Jewelry adhesive
- Heatgun
- Exacto knife
- Skewer or toothpick
- Paper





Step 1: Pick your color(s) and shred or chop the crayons into small pieces.






Step 2: Place your pendant on a piece of paper and add the colors into the open pendant, one color at a time. Use tweezers or a toothpick to be strategic with the placement if you have a design in mind.



Step 3: Melt the crayon by holding up the paper with the pendant on top and heating from below with the heat gun. Allow some space between the gun and paper so it does not burn. Larger chunks will take longer to melt. Ideally, the crayon layer should be lower than the lips of the pendant. If it overflows, we can remove some once it cools.



Step 4: While cooling, you can continue to play with the design by using the toothpick to mix the colors. Allow to cool completely. The crayon layer needs to be below the lip of the pendant for the cabochon to adhere well. If needed, shave the crayon with the toothpick. This is also a good time to clean any edges that may have gotten crayon on it during step three.







Step 5: Once cool, add 4-5 drops of jewelry adhesive on top of the dried melted crayon and set the cabochon on top to dry. Lay flat while drying. The prism will appear foggy but should clear up in 24 hours.







Step 6: Slide pendant onto necklace cord and voila! Your fabulous new handmade accessory is ready!
