

STAMPED BOOK STACKS



Supply List:

Paperback books
White chalk paint
diluted with water (1:1 ratio)
Paint brush
Stamps for lettering
Black ink pad
Twine
Scissors



Step One: Remove cover from books, including spines.

Step Two: Paint books' spines. Allow to dry completely.



Step Three: Using a quick-dry ink, stamp along spine, working from one end to the other. Tip: If the letters are not dark enough, fix with a matching ball point pen. It's easier to darken than to lighten!



Step Four: Once stamped, stack the books in order and tie together with string or twine.



Personalization Ideas: So many options with these! Use shades of brown to distress edges or corners to make a more aged look. Stamp on top of the stack to add flare. Use a piece of greenery or floral stem to decorate top. Tie in buttons or charms. Don't forget to share your fabulous creations on our Way Public Library Facebook page!
