



# Thanksgiving Pie Felt Banner

## Supply List:

Felt (dark brown, medium brown, light tan, orange, white, cream, green)

Yarn

Sheet with pattern pieces

Scissors

Pencil

Hot glue gun and glue sticks OR fabric glue



## For All Pies:

Cut out the pattern pieces. Then trace the shapes onto the corresponding color felt.

Trace and cut 3 *Bottom Crusts* on light tan felt.



Trace and cut 5 *Top Crusts* on light tan felt.

Trace and cut 1 *Pie Filling* of each color—orange, dark brown  
OR medium brown, and cream felt.

Trace and cut 5 *Whip Cream & Pecans* (circles) on white felt.

Trace and cut 8 *Whip Cream & Pecans* (circles) on each color—  
dark brown and medium brown felt.

Trace and cut 6–10 *Skinny Crescents* on green felt.



## For Pumpkin Pie:

Glue the orange *Pie Filling* onto a *Bottom Crust* piece.

For the folded crust, glue the end edges of a *Top Crust* piece onto *Bottom Crust* piece. Starting at one end, gently fold back the crust so that it lays flat. Glue in place. Repeat across crust.

Fold a white *Whip Cream & Pecans* circle in half, gluing with a single dot at the center of the crease. Fold again in half and glue at crease. Repeat to make FOUR (4) quarter folded white pieces.

Glue the FOUR (4) white pieces onto the last white circle to create a dollop of whipped cream! Adhere to orange *Pie Filling*.



### **For Apple Pie:**


Glue the cream *Pie Filling* onto a *Bottom Crust* piece.

Arrange desired amount of apple edges (green *Skinny Crescents*) on top of *Pie Filling* and glue in place.

To make the lattice, cut two *Top Crust* pieces into thirds lengthwise. Then, cut 4 of those pieces in half. Weave them together in a four by four square, alternating going under and over the intersecting pieces. Once complete, glue at each intersection to hold in place.

Glue the lattice on top of the pie. Cut any pieces that overhang the edge or crust line. Use extra pieces to fill in gaps if necessary.

For the pinched crust, glue the end edges of a *Top Crust* piece onto the *Bottom Crust* piece. Starting at one end, pinch a raised fold into the felt then glue into place. Repeat across crust.




### **For Pecan Pie:**

Glue the dark brown or medium brown *Pie Filling* (whichever you chose to cut) onto a *Bottom Crust* piece.

Using the dark brown and medium brown *Whip Cream & Pecans* (circle) pieces, fold each circle in half and glue at the crease to hold. Next, peel back one side of the fold so that the top edge of the circle meets the center crease. Glue in place. Repeat on the other side. Flip and voila pecans!


Arrange the felt pecans on top of the *Pie Filling*, using the side with three folds facing out. Use as many as needed. Glue in place.

For the flat crust, glue a *Top Crust* piece in half lengthwise. Attach onto *Bottom Crust*.



### **For All Pies:**

Add piece of yarn by using extra pieces of *Top Crust* from lattice of apple pie to glue yarn in place on the back of each pie piece.
