

Greetings!

After careful consideration, Way Library has made the difficult decision to close temporarily in response to the COVID-19 pandemic.



The library will be closed from Monday, March 16, 2020 through Sunday, April 5, 2020. Out of an abundance of caution, all programs have been suspended through April 19, 2020.

In the interest of protecting those we serve and supporting the statewide effort to contain the spread of COVID-19, the library will be closed for three weeks. Our reopening date is subject to review based upon ongoing developments with regard to the Coronavirus pandemic.

The library will continue to provide digital services, such as ebooks, downloadable audiobooks, streaming movies, television, and music, access to online magazines, and many other resources. Exterior book drops will remain open while the library is closed, but patrons are welcome to keep all items until the library reopens if they prefer.
